The Mirabel Foundation was established in Victoria in 1998 to assist children who have been orphaned or abandoned due to parental illicit drug use. Mirabel's vision is the belief that every child deserves a childhood and its mission is to break the destructive cycle of addiction. Mirabel supports children aged 0-17 years and works at restoring a child's sense of self-worth, belonging and hope for the future in order for them to reach their full potential as young adults.

The exhibition **opens** at **Lab X Gallery** on **June 16th** from **6 to 8 pm** at **40 Pakington St, St Kilda**, and runs **from June 18 to July 30 2006**. Gallery hours are 7.30am to 9.30pm Monday to Friday, 1 to 7pm Sunday, closed Saturday. Entry to the exhibition is by donation.
